TRASH CHUTE DO's & DON'Ts

The trash chute is used only for common household trash only.

NO GLASS, METAL, LIQUIDS, WOOD, PLASTIC, CARPET, KITTY LITTER or SHARPS ETC!

All trash must be bagged and securely tied.

DO NOT PUT ANYTHING IN THE TRASH CHUTE UNBAGGED!

Fire Safety

Your safety is our priority! As a reminder, emergency escape plans are located on the back of your door (high-rises). Please do not use your stove/oven as a heat source. If you are experiencing any heating issues, please call the office to submit a work order.

The following is how to properly extinguish a grease fire.



STEP ONE:

TURN OFF HEAT SOURCE



STEP TWO:

DO NOT USE WATER TO EXTINGUISH A GREASE FIRE



STEP THREE:

REMOVE ALL OXYGEN- USE A BAKING SHEET OR POTS & PANS TO COVER FIRE



STEP FOUR:

USE SALT OR BAKING SODA TO EXTINGUISH REMAINING FLAMES



STEP FIVE:

IF FIRE PERSISTS, USE A DRY CHEMICAL FIRE EXTINGUISHER



STEP SIX:

CALL 911 IF FIRE BECOMES UN-MANAGEABLE

NO FURNITURE, ACCESSORIES OR
CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS
